### **RULES & REGULATIONS**

We, the committee members of West Bolivar High School, have prepared the following eligibility requirements to acquaint members of the West Bolivar High School Royal Court.

We feel that it is necessary that all members understand what is expected of them. It is our belief that the West Bolivar High School Royal Court will strive to uphold the name of West Bolivar High and West Bolivar Consolidated School District. We believe that with the proper conduct, positive attitude, unity, and teamwork, we can set forth the foundation for a prestigious Royal Court. Being an elected member of the West Bolivar High School Royal Court is more than just a name, title, or crown, but an opportunity for building character, exposure to new ideas and concepts, an increase in community involvement, and building social interaction skills. Our expectation is that the Royal Court will conduct themselves as the Kings or Queens, that they have been elected by the student body. A disciplinary check will be performed by the Homecoming Committee in regards to infractions for this school term as well as previous years.

1. Mr. & Miss West Bolivar High, Queen/King must maintain a 3.5 and Class Maids must maintain a 3.2 G.P.A. throughout the school year.
2. All royal court escorts and class/organization must maintain a "B" average throughout the course of the school term. If by any chance this academic status is not met, titles may be removed.
3. Mr. & Miss West Bolivar High and Queen must be a certified senior and have **passed all (4) four subject area tests.**
4. Any foul attitude, sassing, or uncalled remarks will constitute in an administrative staff meeting to discuss whether or not titles will be removed.
5. Every member of the Royal Court must respect themselves as well as pay highest respect to any adult that will be working with the court.
6. Any member of the Royal Court that is involved in an altercation, fight, or discrepancy, may lose his/her title.

7. Every member of the Royal Court must maintain a clean file in the West Bolivar High office and must not be suspended for anything. Actions will be taken and decisions will be made by the administrative staff.
  8. Each Royal Court member must be loyal. Do not belittle your school to outsiders. **It is imperative to remember that you are the school, too.**
  9. Each Royal Court member must be sharp and keep a high scholastic standing. This is a criterion by which others will judge us. “Getting by” is not a high enough goal.
  10. Each Royal Court member must be honest, maintain a high standard of honesty and self-respect. Do not do anything that is dishonorable to yourself or others.
  11. Female attire will be selected by the homecoming committee. (no exceptions)
  12. Escorts attire will be selected by the homecoming committee. (no exceptions)
  13. All escorts must be grade level.
  14. Parade participation by way of float or vehicle must be decorated by the candidate.
  15. All parade entries must be approved by the principal and/or homecoming committee.
- \*\*\*\*\*Titles may be taken away for the following:**
16. If a major or severe incident occurs that results in ISS, OSS, or expulsion.
  17. If academic status declines.
  18. If a candidate causes any embarrassment or shame to the West Bolivar Consolidated School District.
  19. If a title has been taken away, the alternate will assume the responsibilities of the title.
